



# IN THE PARK PRODUCTIONS

## August 2020 Covid 19 A Bubble of Fun Plan

We are seeking funding to provide some free entertainment in Centre Vale Park Todmorden for August 2020. We believe there is an appetite for some family friendly entertainment.

However we fully appreciate the need for this to be appropriate to the social distancing requirements that are in place.

The area we propose to use is The Old Coach Yard behind the Lucky Dog. The area is large enough to accommodate 16, 2 meter circles (we are calling them bubbles), with 2 meters between each bubble. Each 2 meter bubble would accommodate just one household but could accommodate up to 6 members of the same household. One path leading up (the one nearest the Garden of Remembrance) is long enough to hold 16 lines 2 meters apart to act a queuing space and would act in the way IN. The path on the other side would be the way OUT. Along this path there are then 5 different paths that people could use to disperse. The stewards would release bubbles one at a time to ensure households leave well spaced out.

The performer and head steward come from the same household so would be able to interact as normal. There would be 2 stewards. The Head steward would be in charge of the IN the additional steward in charge of the OUT. There would be bubbles for the stewards to be in to ensure social distancing is appropriate.

The performer would not bring anyone up on to the stage to help. Everyone would stay in their bubble for the duration of the show.

The event would be free because of the funding so there would be no need to exchange money.

We anticipate an average of 4 people per bubble per show so an average of 64 people per show. 5 shows a day. Households would be encouraged to bring something to sit in.

There would be no bubbles up against the back wall, this would be kept clear.

A risk assessment would be created but I presume there is a template the council would like us to use. If not we will create one.

What would we need from the park staff?

The cobbled area could be weeded. This would be important so that the bubbles markings could be seen. We require no other support.

If the council feel any additional daily cleaning work is needed we would be happy too accommodate what is required.
