

Facebook Post About Todmorden Roadworks from Cllr D Tremayne on 20 May 2022

As ward councillors we're very aware how much the issues with traffic lights have affected people this week and how frustrating it has been.

We have had an update from Highways which hopefully provides a bit more information which I am sharing here. I'll add in further information in additional posts as we receive it.

The main congestion has been caused by the interaction of the three way lights and the crossing on Halifax Road. To try to counter congestion caused by this there are now marshalls on the lights to try to help improve the traffic flow. This does seem to have improved from the start of the week.

Works on Water Street should take two weeks maximum. CMBC are replacing the existing tarmac surfacing with heritage materials (on the Halifax Road end of Water Street) and also involve the installation of a zebra crossing across Halifax Road at that same point.

On 19.5.22 CMBC will begin trial holes on the Burnley Road side of the Town Hall in readiness for the installation of a new crossing point.

By mid to late June work will have moved onto Halifax Road (adjacent to Lidl) where the refuge will be replaced with a puffin and additional refuges will be installed. Dates for the remainder of the Corridor Improvement Programme for the A646 are still to be finalised.
