Proposed Highway Improvement Schemes - A646/A6033 Corridor Improvement Programme

Calderdale Council are proposing a package of improvement measures on the A646/A6033 to improve traffic flow, reduce congestion, reduce accidents and stimulate economic growth.

Some of the proposed measures in this area require new Traffic Regulation Orders and/or amendments to existing ones.

- Reversal of the Bus and Taxi Lay-by locations incorporating No Waiting at any time restrictions.

- Various changes to loading and waiting restrictions along Halifax Road outside Castle Hill Primary School to facilitate a new zebra crossing.

- Changes to School Keep Clear Zig Zag markings.
- Removal of the Police Lay-by.

- New Zebra and pelican crossings.
- Entry restrictions along Bond Street, Water Street, School Lane, Brook Street, Calder Street and Bridge Street to allow access for loading only.

- Reversal of the one-way system along School Lane.
- Extension of the existing 20mph speed limit.
