This has given the Friends of Centre Vale Park a higher profile and makes more people aware of the environmental value of our park. Because of this we have gained more members and expect this to continue as news of the booklet leads to sales, and more people reach the download via our website.

If you have received grants from the Town Council before, please advise how you intend to be more self-sustainable and reduce your reliance on Town Council funding for the future.

The increase in membership means we are more sustainable as an organisation and reach a wider public, but for big projects designed to improve people's experience and appreciation of the park we will always have to seek outside funding from a variety of sources. We sell the booklets at £4 each minus discount. This is partly to offset the project unavoidable overspend, and also to part fund a possible second printing.
