Hi Susan

We looked at all the sites and including the ones listed below.

- Patmos Gardens (owned by Todmorden Town Council) *discounted because we are looking to put storage to link people to places and recognising the appropriate location. happy to consider if we see demand or opportunity*
- Railway Archway next to Mount Vets on Burnley Rd *discounted because it was felt that the site didn't feel safe enough and wouldn't encourage cyclists to leave a bike, also stands very close at entrance to Aldi.*
- Weatherspoons Space *is very limited now because of the additional seating that the business are putting out, support for the installation would be needed from the business*
- Market – next to Cryers *waiting for further detail on other infrastructure schemes but agree that there is a need for a stand in this area, we could look at phase 2 installation here.*
- Market – next to side door *I wanted to see if there was an opportunity to put a stand by the seating?*



- Golden Lion *again if we can see the need to connect people to places, happy to consider if we see demand or opportunity.*

Thank you for this. I'll raise an agenda item at the next meeting of the Development Committee on 13 October.

There are several other sites on the proposal that [REDACTED] sent me (attached). These included:

- Patmos Gardens (owned by Todmorden Town Council)
- Railway Archway next to Mount Vets on Burnley Rd
- Weatherspoons
- Market – next to Cryers
- Market – next to side door
- Golden Lion

The two sites around the market are particularly useful ones and will hopefully encourage people to visit the market. It was a request to have stands at the market that kick started my research into cycle stands nearly two years ago.

The proposal at the front of the outdoor market near Cryers would also be a wonderful opportunity to improve a rather scruffy area in the town as Tomo suggested it might be combined with a planter.
