Parliamentary Constituency Boundaries – 2023 Review – Secondary Consultation

The Boundary Commission for England (BCE) is an independent and impartial non-departmental public body, which is responsible for reviewing Parliamentary constituency boundaries in England. It is responsible for conducting UK Parliament constituencies in England and making recommendations to Parliament. The BCE are conducting the review based on the rules which were recently updated in 2020.

The BCE have now published more information on their upcoming secondary consultation on the proposed new map of constituencies across England.

The secondary consultation will take place from Tuesday 22 February to Monday 4 April 2022. During this consultation, you will be able to provide feedback on the proposed new constituencies via their consultation website, bcereviews.org.uk, by email or letter, or in person during a public hearing. The BCE intend to hold 32 public hearings across the country during the consultation period.

Further information about the public hearings will be released sometime in January 2022.

Leeds (lead public hearing for region) - 10th March 2022 Day 1 (10am to 8pm) 11 March 2022 Day 2 (9am to 5pm).

Hull - 14th March 2022 Day 1 (10am to 8pm) 15 March 2022 Day 2 (9am to 5pm).

Northallerton - 17th March 2022 Day 1 (10am to 8pm) 18 March 2022 Day 2 (9am to 5pm).
