Subject	Financial Regulations

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To inform Members that the Resources Committee on the 16th February 2022 reviewed the Financial Regulations and Scheme of Delegation noting these were last reviewed In March 2021.
2. To inform Members that amendments were made to reflect the increasing level of financial activity that will be involved in the Town Council taking on the role of Sponsor for the Town Deals Fund (TDF) Centre Vale Park projects.
3. To inform Members that the exact nature of how funds will be received, controlled, and authorised for payment have not yet been clarified in detail, but the proposed amendments to the Financial Regulations provide the remit through which to operate this increased level of activity, including use of Calderdale MBC’s procurement and supplier framework agreements.
4. To inform Members that once detail is available, a separate paper will be prepared by the Town Clerk /RFO as part of our due diligence process at which stage further amendments may also need to be made to other related Policies.
5. To recommend that the Revised Regulations as per Appendix 1 are submitted to Full Council for adoption.
6. To present below for ease of reference the main changes.
