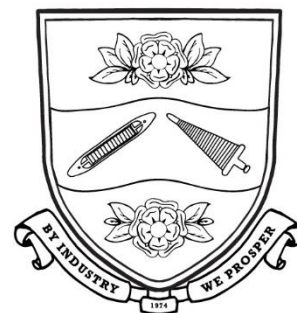

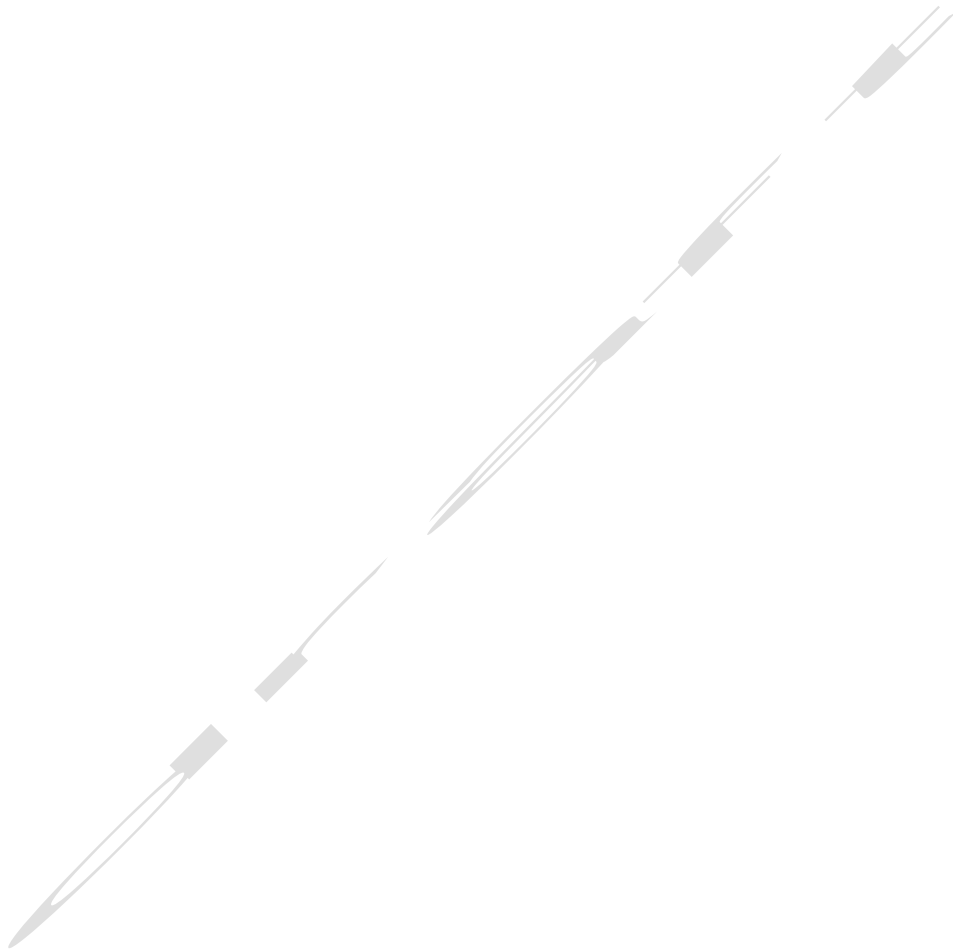

Climate Pledge Presentation by Cllr M Holmstedt – Decision Required</u> To receive a presentation and a Draft Climate Pledge for approval.</p> <p>The draft pledge was warmly received and suggestions were made for it to be launched at the Mayor Making Day (16 October 2021) and the public meeting on flooding (1 November 2021).</p> <p><i>Proposed by Cllr M Taylor and Seconded by Cllr the Revd G Kent Unanimous</i></p> <p>RESOLVED:-<i>That to receive the presentation. Cllr M Holmstedt agreed to add further items to the pledge and to categorise the list. The document and launch to be an agenda item at an upcoming Full Council meeting.</i></p>
2021(CEC)023	<p><u>Item 9. Revisiting Calderdale Council’s Recycling Policy – For Information</u> To receive and review this policy</p> <p>There was considerable discussion about Calderdale Council’s Plastic Recycling Policy. Questions were raised about the accountability of actions arising from the policy, including concern that the recycling waste from some councils is being dumped in countries such as Vietnam and Thailand.</p>

	<p><i>Proposed by Cllr M Taylor and Seconded by Cllr the Revd G Kent Unanimous</i></p> <p>RESOLVED:- That to receive Calderdale Council's Recycling Policy and to keep it under review. Also, to consider extending the examination of the policy to include the recycling of other items, not just plastic. To review the policy again in around 18 months once the current CEC action plan is well underway.</p>
