6a	20/20252/TPO	Unitarian Church Honey Hole Road Todmorden Calderdale OL14 6LE	Management of trees (Prune and Fell) (Tree Preservation Order)	<p>This application is to do some tree work on protected trees at the Unitarian Church on Honey Hole Rd. The comments made about the proposed work state that the trees are causing varying degrees of concern to nearby residents. It looks like the work needs to be done.</p> <p>It is proposed to do the following (as set out in the JCA Ltd report – where their funds allow):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hawthorn (T21) fell as tree is dead. • Mixed species (G23) remove all dead specimens & prune back the collective crown which overhangs the boundary & is very close to adjacent properties. • Grey Poplar (T26) fell as tree is dead & rubbing on stem of T25. • Holly (T33) fell as tree is in poor condition with wood decaying fungi <i>Bjerkandera adusta</i> which is compromising stability. • White Willow (T34) fell as tree in poor condition & has significant lean after being partially uprooted - leans towards footpath. • Sycamore (T48) fell as tree in poor condition with an unbalanced crown which hangs over a footpath - decay at base. • Beech (T61) aerial inspection needed to assess decay at high level. • Rowan (T82) reduce to 2 metres & retain as habitat as severe decay at base limiting long term future. • Mixed species (G84) remove deadwood where it overhangs boundary. • Goat Willow (G85) remove specimen with basal decay & crown clean second specimen. • Sycamore (G87) remove deadwood over footpath. • Common Ash (T88) remove deadwood over footpath.
