<p>This is a new event for Todmorden which we would like to run on an annual basis.</p> <p>We had fifteen different activities running at the event, all based on the theme of cycling and motorcycles. A wide range of local participants gave extremely positive feedback regarding the activities, organisation and good value for money. A number of events were geared towards engaging young, older and fully inclusive access to cycling with high levels of participation. Empowered disabled cycling group had a large presence on the site and reported good engagement from the community. Centrepiece to the event was Mobile Bike Events BMX stunt team who performed amazing tricks throughout the day and fully engaged both young and old. Mayor Pat Taylor joined us for two hours and found the event “amazing and a great benefit for the people of Todmorden”.</p> <p>We sold just over 500 tickets for the event which was about half of what we planned for but given this is the first time the event has run and the fact that the weather the previous week was terrible, we feel 2WheelTod has made a very good start in Todmorden and we look forward to building on this success in future years.</p> <p>In the coming weeks Todmorden Rotary Club will fully evaluate the event and make plans to refine the activities, analyse the target audience and audit the financial success of our event.</p>
