6f	21/00783/FUL	Crab Apple Farm Stoney Royd Lane Todmorden Calderdale OL14 8EP	Wooden field shelter	<p>The proposal is to build a small wooden field shelter so that the land can continue to be used for sheep grazing. This would be situated on a 4-acre field in view of a public right of way. It is stated that it would be in keeping with the landscape and would allow for the green use of the land as the sheep would provide milk and meat and enable the applicants to be more sustainable. It is stated that the sheep manure would provide organic fertiliser for the vegetable plot on the land.</p> <p>The site is a 4-acre field adjoining the recently converted house (from a barn). It has been used for grazing sheep and cows for many years. The applicant wishes to keep their own sheep on the land for milk and meat for themselves. It is stated that the sheep will need a field shelter as the field will be their permanent home. The sheep that used to live on the field were previously transported to other sites during the winter and lambing season. In order to continue to use this field as pastureland, the applicants would like a field shelter. A field shelter for sheep is generally considered good practice, particularly in such an exposed location. In addition, the applicants will need shelter for lambing and milking the sheep. It is stated that the design is a traditional wooden shelter and will blend well with the surrounding area. A plastic mobile shelter would be unsightly and not practical on such a sloping hill.</p> <p>Proposed materials are concrete base, wooden walls and a bitumen sheet for the roof.</p> <p>There are no highway objections.</p>
