EMpowered people have created a unique, fully Inclusive Cycling experience that allows a Disabled person to enjoy the freedom and health benefit that Inclusive Cycling can offer. To have the ability of being involved in a community experience with our fully trained Support Cyclist, and feel the wind on your face is very empowering.

To date we have had over twenty Todmorden people who have come to the charity not knowing what was possible due to their disability. After trying a range of our Inclusive Cycles, our fully adaptive Bike Trains have been the solution that enables them to fulfil their ambition to be independent and part of a Cycling Community which has its base in Todmorden.

The new Bike Trains will allow more of our local residents to become active and more healthy, and in doing so promote our Town as a beacon of Inclusive and Adaptive Cycling that no other Town offers.

Our centre is open three times per week for anyone to visit and see the range of Inclusive Cycles that we have to offer. We would arrange a convenient time for their visit and try our bikes on a Taster experience. We work on a one to one basis developing their skills and confidence with our cycles. If the person requires more help and support due to their condition, then we would introduce our Bike Trains that enable a person with complex disabilities to start to cycle. We work with each person, adapting and modifying the bikes to meet with their own requirements. Tater days usually first Saturday in each month from our:-
