

Todmorden Town Council's Climate Emergency Committee has set up a small climate grant scheme for local individuals/organisations who wish to deliver small-scale projects that tackle issues related to climate change and provide environmental benefits for the local community.

There are also available grants for local climate-related projects from other funding bodies, such as the Crook Hill Community Benefit Fund and Reaps Moss Community Benefit Fund.
