

Roadworks in Todmorden – Email Exchange Email Update

Hopefully this will assist:

- Would it be possible, please, to have a detailed timetable of events with an associated map, available for the proposed 30 weeks, so that people can see where the roadworks will impact on specific dates? I've instructed that the "Calderdale the Next Chapter" website be kept updated with this information. This can be found at the following <https://www.calderdalenextchapter.co.uk/projects/a58a672-and-a646a6033-improvements> We will shortly be engaging a new project manager and updating the site will be within his remit. I'll also ask him to confirm the advanced programme but that will be subject to change as, inevitably, all civil engineering projects are.
- Would it be possible, please, for work to be scheduled to avoid peak travelling times (for example, could it be done in the evenings)? Wherever possible that will be the case. However, your members should note that working limited hours will lengthen the time that it takes to deliver the overall works.
- Would it be possible, please, to monitor the impact of the roadworks/sequencing of traffic lights, so that delays can be reduced as much as possible? We have already started to do that. Whilst the works at Water Street were being carried out we note that there was negative interaction between the temporary lights and the adjacent light controlled crossings. Consequently, we placed traffic marshals on site to monitor the works and adjust the signal timings appropriately.
- Would it be feasible, please, to advise drivers, before they reach the town centre, of alternative routes such as via Hallroyd Rd? This will be the case.
