<p>Golden Lion Sounds CIC was founded during the pandemic, in January 2021. Whilst live music venues were closed we sought to create a new and sustainable outlet for local and touring musicians who would normally visit The Golden Lion. The core idea was to release vinyl records and to support this with live streams and merchandise.</p> <p>We have successfully released 14 records including 7" singles, a 12" EP and a full album by local band Plank. We have 2 more singles currently awaiting manufacture and plan to release a compilation record of Todmorden based artists in the next 6 months.</p>		

Over half of the releases so far have featured local artists and several young, new & emerging bands. We have presented a series of live streams covering both music and health & wellbeing. All this work has helped raise the profiles and careers of working musicians in Todmorden and is a channel for artists to release their work.

We have also organised a large community event at Todmorden Learning centre with 300-500 people visiting over the course of the day and members of the British Thai community visiting from all over the country.
