Scalcliffe Hall

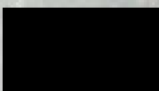

Concerns about litter and blocked culvert

We are always keen to work with local people to organise litter picks and to generally tidy up their neighbourhoods, including making sure adequate arrangements are in place for the removal and disposal of rubbish. Our Volunteer Coordinator, Amy Powell-Bevan, will be in touch to discuss how we might best facilitate this on the Western Gateway to Calderdale as you suggest. A member of our Flood Risk Management team will also be in touch to better understand the concern you have raised regarding obstruction to the culverted watercourse and will advise on any action required.
