- Overall Crime up slightly YTD from January
- Burglary numbers in Todmorden have increased slightly, but less so than the rest of Calderdale.
- Theft from motor Vehicles in Todmorden Reducing
- Reports of ASB in the Todmorden area reducing

Daily Duties- PCSOs

- Parade & Brief at Todmorden
- Dedicated and focussed patrols in Todmorden
- Briefed and tasked on local crime, Intelligence and nominals of note
- School visits and patrols
- High Visibility foot Patrols in Crime and ASB Hot-Spot locations
- Contact points and engagement events.
- Road Safety Work
- Focus on Safer Cleaner Greener Priorities as set via ward forums and the SCG meeting (6 weekly)
- Working earlies and late on a 7-day shift pattern

Upper Valley SCG Priorities 13/11/2023

1. Road safety across the UV with a particular focus on

- **Focus on Oldham Road and surrounding area (Ryburn)**
- **Focus on Rochdale Road and surround area (Todmorden)**

- We will do this through targeted Road Safety work deployments, working with partners to inform & educate communities and enforce road safety legislation. This will include SID and Pro-Laser deployments, and proactive work to identify and prosecute unsafe use of the road network.

2. Crime prevention and target hardening

- **Focus on Luddenfoot area (Theft of Motor Vehicles).**
- **Focus on Todmorden area (Burglary Offences)**

-We will do this as part of the Calderdale Darker Nights operation, through engagement activities in communities, at contact points, and by using crime data to identify areas which may be most at risk from acquisitive crime and conducting proactive patrols in those areas.

3. Anti-Social Behaviour

- **Focus on Sowerby Bridge area.**

- We will do this through a partnership approach to increase awareness of anti-social behaviour reporting methods, identify repeat victims and perpetrators of anti-social behaviour, and educate young people of the impact of ASB. We will adopt a problem-solving approach to locations/victims and perpetrators of ASB to prevent escalation and repeat

Anti-Social Behaviour Update - Todmorden

- **14 % reduction in reported ASB Jan-Oct compared to previous year**
- 2 x ASB Warning letters for 2 youths identified for ASB issues in Centre Vale Park.
- 1 x ABC issued to a youths for ASB issues around the centre of Todmorden and Centre Vale Park.
- 8 x ASB warning letters, 2 x ASB Referrals issued after an incident of disorder at Aldi, Burnley Rd, Todmorden.
- 1 x ASB Referral for an adult male.
- 1 x Youth identified for criminal damage to window of bus station. Issued a conditional caution to engage with YJS.
- PCSO's have been involved in the knife arch deployment in and around Todmorden market.
- Regular patrols of locations of high footfall and demand such a such as the market, bus station and Centre Vale park.

Road Safety Update – Todmorden

- **31 % reduction in Injury RTC's. 20% increase in damage only RTC's**
- PCSO's have conducted patrols at School at drop off time to enforce the new one-way system and school street road closure.
- Regular work with Special Constables conducting speed checks in the Todmorden area.
- Regular SID and Pro-laser Deployments.
- Deployments of Op-Hawmill resources to the locality to identified issues.
- Support enforcement actions against Fatal4 offences.
