The purpose of the film is to commemorate Stansfield View and the people who lived and worked there and the act as a legacy of that era.</p> <p>The film will be used to raise awareness at universities of the history of people with learning disabilities, as well as at other conferences and events.</p> <p>This is part of a wider social history project along with the siting of a blue plaque, the creation of an online website where archive footage and related information about Stansfield can be accessed and for a notice board with information and photographs of Stansfield View and associated walk taking in significant landmarks related to the hospital and its history.</p>
