<p>The new goals were very much welcomed by the incumbent junior football club who are calling Riverside Centre their Home Ground now. This has sent a signal to detractors that we are serious about supporting football development and has kept cost down for them as they would have had to fund raise for the type of goals they wanted and we couldn't provide from our resources or income from them. This grant helped to secure the additional funding from the FA for them to fund the goals too. The club love the fact that the goals are movable on wheels and so they do not have to put them up each week and fix nets. The number of playing teams using these goals is currently/usually two per Sunday.</p>

The grant shows that the council and the UCVR literally share a common **goal** to support the provisions for this sport and in general continue to have mutually beneficial working relationship.

The Riverside Project now funded by the Towns Fund, aims to be as self-sufficient as possible in the future by creating multiple income generating opportunities for use of the site. The nature of the project will however, rely on some grant funding for specific users where that cannot be derived from general income.
