The aims of Thai Festival, Fair & Community Exchange was to introduce to the town and bring together with the people of Todmorden the Thai community in and around Calderdale. The day was a massive success in these areas. Thai Buddhist monks performed religious ceremonies, there was free Thai dancing and entertainment in the afternoon along a Thai Food and general market which was well attended by local community leaders and local people. For the daytime event including all volunteers, traders, performers, other delegates and visitors there were 200-300 attendees.

Another objective was to support Todmorden Learning Centre (TLC) in showcasing their ability to hold large events. The event was a total success in this respect. TLC facilitated a full concert in the evening with over 250 attendees. The headline act is one of the leading Thaiac Pop singers, Mai Charoenpura. This was perhaps the largest gathering of Thai people in the North of England in recent times.
