

## **Item 15 Development Committee 3 January 2024**

### **Review of Parking Charges – Phase 2 – Proposed Parking Places Order (PPO) Calderdale Council Formal Consultation**

Calderdale are currently consulting on its proposals to introduce charges/changes for parking across Calderdale including Todmorden. In Todmorden this impacts the three car parks where car parking is currently free. These are the car parks on Dale Street, Dalton Street, Oxford Street (see appendixes 1-3).

The proposed charges are for Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm: up to 1 hour free, up to 2 hours 40p, up to 3 hours 80p, up to 4 hours £1.20, up to 5 hours £1.60 and over 5 hours £2.00.

It is stated that the changes are required because of the Climate Emergency (with associated air quality issues), the need to put in place a good parking management and charging policy to positively influence travel behaviour and encourage active travel.

The deadline for feedback to Calderdale Council is Thursday 4 January 2024.

The Development Committee will need to decide what, if any, feedback should be given Calderdale Council.
