Tod Support distributes money from 2 charities for people in need in Todmorden. Town Council grant paid for a website [www.todsupport.org.uk](http://www.todsupport.org.uk) and printed publicity, which was part of a complete overhaul of the organisation. We knew that many people in need were unaware of Tod Support and how could they be when there was no website, phone number, email, or publicity. Publicity is now distributed around the town and to key partner organisations with supplies at both food banks. People in need of help can now ask via the website by email, by phoning.

**Trends in requests for help**

2021 **21 cases** Prior to reorganisation and with no profile. Referrals virtually all from Job Centre  
 2022 **118 cases** During reorganisation but with monthly drop in session at Food Drop In established.  
 2023 **245 cases.** Website was launched on October 23<sup>rd</sup> with publicity distributed at the same time. **104 of the 245 people** who asked for help in 2023 did so in the final quarter when the publicity and website were launched.

Website and publicity are also key to ensuring people across the town can access help regardless of where they live. The figures below reflect the geographical spread where people who received help lived and what they needed. Without the marketing, it is very likely that a number of people needing help would have remained unaware of the help available from Tod Support.
