Part fund employed position to:- Support community groups to operationally run a Bandstand and Bowling Pavilion (wider group and community use) Help community groups seek out external grant funding opportunities and where cross cutting themes work together to attract larger pots for funding for collective delivery of funders output requirements. Help and support implementation of good governance/organisational structure. Enable Old Library building in deprived area to open more for community use. Support community groups in understanding activity impact re sustainability and climate, All groups involved will benefit and wider public by users of facilities and or participation in events. Tangible support to volunteer groups and provide expertise to help obtain external grant fundraising will greatly enhance delivery of volunteer groups activities for wider community benefit. Programme focussed over 12 month activity period- possibly extend to 18 months. Promoted through direct engagement with groups, press releases, web site and social media for wider audience. When proven successful anticipated that further financial support may be forthcoming from Town Council to extend as either fully funded and or part with further grant funding sought on a project specific basis. Todmorden Town Council(TTC) has secured funds from Town Deal Fund, Communities Ownership Fund and National Heritage Lottery Fund to deliver c £1.1m of capital works only to improve / build new facilities for volunteer group use .

<https://todtccentrevaleparkprojects.org.uk/> TTC currently support voluntary group through grants circa £76k. £10k Old Library Food bank – Cornholme and Portsmouth Old library, £10k Todmorden in Bloom and £43k PCSO provision. Securing funding for employed position £35k including on costs plus £5k operational provision . Balance of £20k funded by Town Council £11k and £9k revenue grant from COF .

TTC currently working with Bandstand Group Bowls Club, Veterans (Armed Forces retirees)Friends of Centre Vale Park, Todmorden Tennis Club, Fielden Hall for delivery of Town Deal Centre Vale Projects. Direct grant support annually usually to c20 local voluntary groups <https://todmorden-tc.gov.uk/grants-awarded/> Currently derelict properties bandstand and pavilion being improved that matter to the local community. Awards for All will assist in reinforcing and providing practical support to operational groups by part funding direct resource support. Increasing opening days for Old Library to enable more community activity delivery plus further food bank accessibility to community in deprived area. Providing grant funding seeking expertise to cascade knowledge down and improve resilience of existing groups through in house development of expertise on a range of issues. Provide governance structures and policy advice for new voluntary groups to be established. Create one full time well paid employed position for 12 months.

Residents supported renovation of Edwardian Bandstand (not used since 2007 and in derelict state).3000 signature petition achieving Grade 2 listed status . Survey re support for Pavilion over 200 positive responses. Centre Vale Park fully accessible for all community to use. Range of voluntary groups delivering a range of events across Todmorden (often grant supported by TTC) deliver opportunity for many free to access as well as paid for events. Centre Vale Park Projects came from community engagement and consultation with strong support for all projects. TTC agreed to support ownership of Bandstand and Pavilion and £25k annual revenue support to underwrite operational costs ton support community for these facilities to be retained. Regular engagement through grant award processes and direct "working group" involvement with Centre Vale Park Project groups lead to feedback that some direct support provision by TTC would help them in obtain funding, improving governance and developing better operational management and systems. Membership of voluntary groups is specific to their field of interest.. TTTC does have external representation on several outside bodies. All direct user groups welcome this proposed support. The wider voluntary group sector has not been directly approached but can be-managing expectations.
